COUNTY PERMIT APPLICATION HEARING AND REVIEW SCHEDULED: Permitting processes for the [Southern Delivery System](#) (SDS) in Pueblo and Fremont Counties continue moving forward, providing many opportunities for public input.

At the request of Pueblo County, the Southern Delivery System project participants – led by Colorado Springs – held four informational public meetings in Pueblo during the month of October. The meetings have been well attended and have provided us an opportunity to communicate the impacts and [benefits of the project to Pueblo](#). Meetings focused on impacts to [Lake Pueblo State Park](#), to [property owners in Pueblo West](#) and to [Fountain Creek](#). Now that the SDS 1041 permit application has been deemed complete, the Pueblo Board of County Commissioners has scheduled a public hearing on Dec. 9, 2008 at 6 p.m., in the Jackson Conference Room of the Sangre de Cristo Arts and Conference Center, 210 N. Santa Fe Ave. in Pueblo, to review and consider final action on the permit application.

In Fremont County, we are preparing additional information requested by the County for the Special Review Use Permit application we submitted. The Fremont County Department of Planning and Zoning has included review of the SDS Special Review Use Permit application on the agenda for its Dec. 2, 2008 Planning Commission meeting at 7 p.m. in the Fremont County Administration Building in Canon City. Informational meetings were also recently held with potentially affected property owners in Fremont County.

“We are very pleased that the permit processes in both Counties are moving forward,” said John Fredell, SDS Project Director.

In addition, the Bureau of Reclamation recently held a formal public hearing on its [Supplemental Information Report](#) to accept public comment. The comment period for the SIR runs through Nov. 24, 2008. You can view the entire report or find additional information at www.sdseis.com.
