BUREAU OF RECLAMATION HOSTS LISTENING SESSION IN PUEBLO: The Bureau of Reclamation is hosting a listening session Thursday night (May 29) at the Sangre de Cristo Arts and Conference Center (210 North Santa Fe Avenue) in Pueblo to listen to and record comments by the public about the [Southern Delivery System](#) (SDS).

The session begins at 6 p.m. People wanting to speak can register beginning at 5:30 p.m. Statements will be limited to three minutes per commenter. A third-party moderator will facilitate the session and a court reporter will transcribe the comments.

Mike Collins, area manager for Reclamation's Eastern Colorado office, will host the meeting and representatives from each of the four project participants – Colorado Springs, Pueblo West, Fountain and Security – will also participate in the session to provide brief comments. Colorado Springs Utilities will be represented by Chief Water Services Officer Bruce McCormick.
