El Paso County Planning Commission Approves SDS Location Approval

Applications: On Tuesday, March 16, Colorado Springs Utilities received unanimous approval from the El Paso County Planning Commission on three location approval applications for the [Southern Delivery System](#) (SDS) project.

The Commissioners approved applications for the Bradley Pump Station, Upper Williams Creek Reservoir, and the Exchange Flow Facilities including Williams Creek Reservoir. The Planning Commission approved applications for the raw- and treated-water pipelines on March 2.

“Today’s approval is the culmination of a lot of hard work on the part of El Paso County Development Services staff and the Planning Commission,” said John Fredell, SDS Project Director. “We appreciate the time and effort they put into reviewing our applications and are pleased to be one important step closer to the start of construction.”
