SDS federal contract negotiations continue:The [Southern Delivery System](#) (SDS) project team will continue contract negotiations with the Bureau of Reclamation for storage, conveyance, and exchange of water rights owned by the SDS partner communities using facilities of the federal Fryingpan-Arkansas Project, including Pueblo Reservoir.

The next public negotiation session is scheduled for Tuesday, August 24 starting at 9 a.m. and will continue (if needed) at 9 a.m. on Wednesday, August 25 at the Pueblo Shrine Club, 1501 West McCulloch Blvd., Pueblo West, Colorado.

The SDS negotiating team's goal is to ensure certainty of water supply at reasonable costs to the communities they represent – Colorado Springs, Fountain, Security and Pueblo West. The SDS partner communities, all contributors to and beneficiaries of the Fry-Ark Project, are seeking fairness and equity in the price to store, convey and exchange their water using Pueblo Reservoir.
