SDS Project Proponents Hosting Public Information Sessions
Meetings Will Focus on 1041 Permit Application

Colorado Springs – The participants in the Southern Delivery System (SDS) project are hosting four public meetings to inform Pueblo residents about topics related to 1041 land-use permit application – including construction activities, facilities and potential impacts to Lake Pueblo State Park, Pueblo West and Fountain Creek.

“The purpose of these meetings is to inform Pueblo County residents about the 1041 permit-related construction and mitigation activities in the communities we are working with and hear their comments,” said SDS Project Director John Fredell. The informational meetings will combine an open house format with a presentation and question and answer session.

The meetings will address proposed facilities and construction activities planned within Pueblo West. The same meeting will be repeated twice.

Meeting on Fountain Creek -- Thursday, October 30, 2008

The meeting will address the state of Fountain Creek today, potential SDS impacts to Fountain Creek, and Colorado Springs’ and other regional efforts underway to improve Fountain Creek.
